8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, certain income from the
9 Alabama Trust Fund is distributed to the county
10 capital improvement funds of each of the 67
11 counties of the state. These funds may be expended
12 by the counties for limited purposes.

13 This bill would propose an amendment to the
14 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, providing that in
15 Randolph County moneys paid into the Randolph
16 County Capital Improvement Fund pursuant to
17 Amendment 668 of the Constitution of Alabama of
18 1901, now appearing as Section 219.05 of the
19 Official ReCompilation of the Constitution of
20 Alabama of 1901, as amended, may be expended for
21 economic development projects.

23 A BILL
24 TO BE ENTITLED
25 AN ACT

1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of
2 Alabama of 1901, relating to Randolph County; to provide that
3 the moneys paid into the Randolph County Capital Improvement
4 Fund pursuant to Amendment 668 of the Constitution of Alabama
5 of 1901, now appearing as Section 219.05 of the Official
6 Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as
7 amended, may be expended for economic development projects.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. The following amendment to the
10 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become
11 valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of
12 this act are fulfilled:

13 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

14 Moneys paid into the Randolph County Capital
15 Improvement Fund pursuant to Amendment 668 of the Constitution
16 of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 219.05 of the
17 Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901,
18 as amended, may be expended for economic development projects.

19 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
20 shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the
21 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section
22 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
23 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this
24 state.

25 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
26 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
27 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the

1 following description of the substance or subject matter of
2 the proposed constitutional amendment:

3 "Relating to Randolph County, proposing an amendment
4 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide that the
5 moneys paid into the Randolph County Capital Improvement Fund
6 pursuant to Amendment 668 of the Constitution of Alabama of
7 1901, now appearing as Section 219.05 of the Official
8 Recompile of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as
9 amended, may be expended for economic development projects

10 "Proposed by Act _____"
