The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and 3 shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in 5 accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution 6 7 of Alabama of 1901, as amended: PROPOSED AMENDMENT 8 Section 56 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, 9 10 relating to legislative immunity, is hereby repealed. 11 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 12 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the 13 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 14 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of 15 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this 16 state. 17 Section 3.
