10 TO BE ENTITLED

13 Relating to Lauderdale County; to amend Section 1 of
14 Act 800 of the 1975 Special Session (Acts 1975, p. 1604),
15 relating to supplementing the salary or compensation paid to
16 semi-retired or retired circuit judges of the 11th Judicial
17 Circuit; to prohibit supplementing the salaries or
18 compensation of a semi-retired or retired circuit judge who
19 has not vested in the Retirement Systems of Alabama; and to
20 provide that the supplement received by each circuit judge who
21 has vested in the Retirement Systems of Alabama shall be paid
22 pursuant to the formula as provided in Act 800.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

24 Section 1. Section 1 of Act 800 of the 1975 Special
25 Session (Acts 1975, p. 1604) is amended to read as follows:

26 "(a) Any semi-retired or retired circuit judge in
27 the 11th Judicial Circuit shall be entitled to receive as

1 additional compensation payable from the treasury of the
2 county, a sum equal to one and one half percent of the
3 compensation paid said judge by the State of Alabama for each
4 year served as circuit judge up to a maximum of 25 percent.
5 The salaries or compensation provided for herein is
6 supplementary to the salaries or compensation paid the judges
7 by the state and shall be paid out of the general funds of the
8 county in twelve equal monthly installments on warrants
9 properly drawn against the funds.

10 "(b) The additional compensation may not be paid to
11 a semi-retired or retired circuit judge who has not vested in
12 the Retirement Systems of Alabama as of the date of the
13 enactment of this act.

14 "(c) Each circuit judge receiving a retirement
15 supplement pursuant to this act and who has vested in the
16 Retirement Systems of Alabama shall receive a retirement
17 supplement pursuant to the formula provided in subsection
18 (a)."

19 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
20 first day of the third month following its passage and
21 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
