23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
24	Section 1. Section 1 of Act 800 of the 1975 Special
25	Session (Acts 1975, p. 1604) is amended to read as follows:
26	"(a) Any semi-retired or retired circuit judge in
27	the 11th Judicial Circuit shall be entitled to receive as

additional compensation payable from the treasury of the county, a sum equal to one and one half percent of the compensation paid said judge by the State of Alabama for each year served as circuit judge up to a maximum of 25 percent. The salaries or compensation provided for herein is supplementary to the salaries or compensation paid the judges by the state and shall be paid out of the general funds of the county in twelve equal monthly installments on warrants properly drawn against the funds.

- "(b) The additional compensation may not be paid to a semi-retired or retired circuit judge who has not vested in the Retirement Systems of Alabama as of the date of the enactment of this act.
- "(c) Each circuit judge receiving a retirement supplement pursuant to this act and who has vested in the Retirement Systems of Alabama shall receive a retirement supplement pursuant to the formula provided in subsection (a)."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
