10 TO BE ENTITLED

13 Relating to Etowah County; to provide for the  
14 payment into the Sheriff's Law Enforcement Fund certain monies  
15 received by the county commission and paid over to the fund;  
16 and to provide for retroactive effect.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

18 Section 1. In Etowah County, there is currently  
19 being paid by the Etowah County Commission to the Sheriff's  
20 Law Enforcement Fund created by Act 87-644, 1987 Regular  
21 Session (Acts 1987, p. 1149), a portion of certain monies  
22 received by the Etowah County Commission from U. S.  
23 Immigration and Customs Enforcement.

24 Section 2. Any and all monies paid to the Sheriff's  
25 Law Enforcement Fund from sources identified in Section 1  
26 shall continue to be paid to the fund and used in a manner  
27 consistent with the uses provided for by Act 87-644.

1           Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict  
2 with this act are repealed.

3           Section 4. The provisions of this act are severable.  
4 If any part of this act is declared invalid or  
5 unconstitutional, that declaration shall not affect the part  
6 which remains.

7           Section 5. This act shall be retroactive to fiscal  
8 year beginning October 1, 2004, and any payments by the county  
9 commission to the Sheriff's Law Enforcement Fund and any  
10 expenditures by the sheriff in accordance with this act are  
11 hereby validated and confirmed.
