8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, the chemical compounds  
9 HU-210, JWH-018, and JWH-073 are not listed as  
10 controlled substances.

11 This bill would add HU-210, JWH-018, and  
12 JWH-073 to the Schedule I controlled substances  
13 list.

17 AN ACT

19 Relating to Schedule I controlled substances, to add  
20 HU-210, JWH-018, and JWH-073 to the controlled substance list.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

22 Section 1. The following chemical compounds are  
23 added to the Schedule I controlled substances list:

24 (1) (6aR,10aR)-9-(hydroxymethyl)-6,  
25 6-dimethyl-3-(2methyloctan-2-yl)-6a,7,10,10a -  
26 tetrahydrobenzo[c]chromen-1-ol, some trade or other names:  
27 HU-210.

(2) 1-Pentyl-3-(1-naphthoyl)indole, some trade or other names: JWH-018.

(3) 1-Butyl-3-(1-naphthoyl)indole, some trade or other names: JWH-073.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
