6	Alabama State Board of Occupational Therapy, created and				
7	functioning pursuant to Sections 34-39-1 to 34-39-16,				
8	inclusive, Code of Alabama 1975, is continued, and those code				
9	sections are expressly preserved.				
10	Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the				
11	recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in				
12	Sections 1 and 2.				
13	Section 4. This act shall become effective				
14	immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or				
15	its otherwise becoming law.
