9	Residential Codes Board is responsible for
10	providing a process for the acceptance, adoption,
11	and implementation of the Alabama Energy and
12	Residential Codes by the State of Alabama.
13	This bill would include the Director of the
14	Alabama Building Commission as a member of the
15	board.

18	TO BE ENTITLED
19	AN ACT
20	
21	To amend Section 41-23-82, Code of Alabama 1975,
22	relating to the Alabama Energy and Residential Codes Board, to
23	add the Director of the Alabama Building Commission to the
24	membership of the board.
25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
26	Section 1. Section 41-23-82, Code of Alabama 1975,
27	is amended to read as follows:

1	"§41-23-82.
2	"(a) The Alabama Energy and Residential Codes Board
3	is established.
4	"(b) The board shall consist of $\frac{15}{18}$ members.
5	Fifteen members shall be appointed by the Governor, and two
6	additional members, numbered 16 and 17, shall be appointed by
7	the Chair of the Permanent Joint Legislative Committee on
8	Energy Policy, and one member shall be the Director of the
9	Alabama Building Commission or his or her designee. The
10	members appointed by the Governor shall be legal residents of
11	the state, and shall be selected on the basis of their
12	representation of the following organizations, industries,
13	entities, and professions they are appointed to represent. The
14	membership of the board shall include all of the following:
15	"(1) One member shall represent the Home Builders
16	Association.
17	"(2) One member shall represent the Board of General
18	Contractors.
19	"(3) One member shall represent the State Board of
20	Heating, Air Conditioning, and Refrigeration.
21	"(4) One member shall represent the private,
22	investor-owned, electric utility industry.
23	"(5) One member shall represent the rural electric
24	cooperative industry.
25	"(6) One member shall represent the natural gas
26	industry.

Τ	"(/) One member shall be a licensed professional
2	engineer.
3	"(8) One member shall represent municipalities.
4	"(9) One member shall represent county governments.
5	"(10) One member shall represent the Alabama
6	Council, American Institute of Architects.
7	"(11) One member shall represent the Alabama
8	Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board.
9	"(12) One member shall represent the International
10	Code Council (ICC) Alabama Chapter, Code Officials Association
11	of Alabama.
12	"(13) One member shall represent the Home Builders
13	Licensure Board.
14	"(14) One member shall represent the Alabama Joint
15	Fire Council.
16	"(15) One member shall represent the Property and
17	Casualty Insurance Industry.
18	"(16) One member shall be a Senate member of the
19	Permanent Joint Legislative Committee on Energy Policy
20	selected by the chair of the committee.
21	"(17) One member shall be a House of Representatives
22	member of the Permanent Joint Legislative Committee on Energy
23	Policy selected by the chair of the committee.
24	"(18) One member shall be the Director of the
25	Alabama Building Commission, or his or her designee.
26	"(c) Each member appointed by the Governor shall be
27	selected from a list of three candidates provided to the

Governor by the division from each entity listed above. Board appointees shall be selected on the basis of their interest in problems concerning residential energy resources, consumption, and conservation, and without regard to political affiliation. Appointments shall be of such a nature as to aid the work of the board and to inspire the highest degree of coordination and cooperation. All members of the board shall be deemed members at-large charged with the responsibility of serving the best interests of the board, the division, the units of local government, and the state. No member shall act as the representative of any particular region, United States congressional district in Alabama, or state Senate or legislative district in Alabama.

- "(d) The board shall exercise authority with respect to all matters pertaining to the acceptance, adoption, and implementation of the Alabama Energy and Residential Codes by the State of Alabama. Decisions of the board shall be administered by the chief of the division with the assistance of such other officers and department employees as are deemed necessary to carry out the purpose, functions, duties, and activities of the board.
- "(e) The membership of the board shall be inclusive and should reflect the racial, gender, geographic, urban/rural, and economic diversity of the state.
- "(f) This article shall not apply to the erection or construction of a farm structure. The term farm structure, for the purposes of this act, means a structure that is

constructed on a farm, other than a residence or a structure 1 2 attached to it, for use on the farm including, but not limited to, barns, sheds, and poultry houses. A farm structure does 3 not include a structure originally qualifying as a farm 4 5 structure but later converted to another use." Section 2. This act shall become effective 6 7 immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law. 8
