9		Forever Wild Land Trust carried out pursuant to
10		Amendment 543 of the Constitution of Alabama of

Pursuant to the authority provided under Section 13 of Amendment 543 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 13 of Section 219.07 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, this bill would extend payments into the Forever Wild Land Trust in its present form for 20 years for the purpose of continuing the Forever Wild land acquisition program.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Pursuant to the authority granted to the Legislature in Section 13 of Amendment 543 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 13 of Section 219.07 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, beginning with the state's 2012-2013 fiscal year and each succeeding fiscal year thereafter, payment of the revenues provided in Section 7 of Amendment 543 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 7 of Section 219.07 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, into the Forever Wild Land Trust is hereby extended for 20 years.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
