26	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

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## PROPOSED AMENDMENT

- (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, beginning in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013 and continuing through the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017, all oil and gas capital payments received by the state for the right to explore and drill for or to produce oil, gas, or other hydrocarbon minerals in any offshore area of the state other than the amounts necessary to meet debt service requirement on outstanding general obligation bonds, shall be distributed in equal proportions to each congressional district in the state as these districts exist on the effective date of this amendment and used exclusively to help create jobs and retain existing jobs. For the purposes of this amendment, the term "oil and gas capital payment" shall have the same meaning as provided under Amendment 666 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 219.04 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of 1901, as amended.
- (b) The Governor in conjunction with the Alabama

  Development Office, shall decide how the funds provided to

  each congressional district will be utilized to create and/or

1 retain jobs within each district. Provided, however, none of 2 the funds may be utilized to provided highway infrastructure. Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 3 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 5 6 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of 7 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state at the June 5, 2012 statewide primary election. 8 9 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 10 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 11 12 following description of the substance or subject matter of 13 the proposed constitutional amendment: 14 "Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of 15 Alabama of 1901, as amended, to provide for the distribution of offshore oil and gas capital payments received by the state 16 17 to provide funds to help create and retain jobs."
