24	any room or rooms, lodging, or accommodations to transients in

1 regularly furnished to transients for a consideration, in an amount of five percent of the charge for the room, rooms, 3 lodgings, or accommodations, including the charge for use or rental of personal property and services furnished in the room; provided, however, that there is exempted from the tax 5 6 levied under this act any rentals or services taxed under 7 Division 1 of Article 1 of Chapter 23 of Title 40, Code of Alabama 1975. The tax shall not apply to rooms, lodgings, or 8 9 accommodations supplied for a period of 30 continuous days or more in any place. 10

Section 3. The tax herein levied shall be collected in the same manner as the state lodgings tax as provided in Chapter 26, Title 40, Code of Alabama 1975, and the net proceeds, less a reasonable cost of collection not to exceed five percent, from the tax shall be paid into the county treasury to be distributed as follows:

- (1) Ninety percent to a fund established by the Perry County Commission for reduction of the county debt.
- (2) Ten percent to be distributed to the Perry County General Fund.

Section 4. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
