SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, a resident of this state on active military duty who is in this state on leave and who has proof of that status in his or her possession may hunt and fish without a license.

This bill would provide that a resident of this state who is an active member of the Alabama National Guard and who has proof of that status in his or her possession may hunt and fish without a license.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

To add Section 9-11-35.2 to the Code of Alabama 1975; to provide that a resident of this state who is an active member of the Alabama National Guard and who has proof of that status in his or her possession may hunt and fish without a license.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1 Section 1. Section 9-11-35.2 is added to the Code of
2 Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

3 §9-11-35.2.

4 A resident of this state who is an active member of
5 the Alabama National Guard and who has proof of that status in
6 his or her possession may hunt and fish without a license
7 required by Section 9-11-44, 9-11-53, or 9-11-53.1.

8 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
9 first day of the third month following its passage and
10 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
