8 SYNOPSIS: Current law provides for distribution of  
9 tobacco revenues received by the state to specified  
10 funds and entities, including the Children First  
11 Trust Fund.

12 This bill would provide for transfer to the  
13 State General Fund during fiscal year 2012 that  
14 portion of Children First Trust Fund receipts  
15 currently allocated for the State Board of  
16 Education.

19 TO BE ENTITLED

22 To provide for transfer to the State General Fund  
23 during fiscal year 2012 that portion of Children First Trust  
24 Fund receipts currently allocated for the State Board of  
25 Education.

26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any provision of Division 1 of Article 17 of Chapter 10 of Title 41, Code of Alabama 1975, any provision of Chapter 15B of Title 41, Code of Alabama 1975, or any other provision of law, that portion of Children First Trust Fund receipts currently allocated for the State Board of Education shall be transferred from the Children First Trust Fund to the State General Fund during the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
