8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would propose a local
9 constitutional amendment for Montgomery County to
10 decrease the terms of office of members of the
11 board of education from six to four years.

13 A BILL

14 TO BE ENTITLED

15 AN ACT

16
17 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of
18 Alabama of 1901, pertaining only to Montgomery County; to
19 decrease the term of office of members of the board from six
20 to four years.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

22 Section 1. The following amendment to the
23 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become
24 valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of
25 this act are fulfilled:

26 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

1 As terms of office on the Montgomery County Board of
2 Education expire, new members shall be elected to the board
3 for terms of four years.

4 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
5 shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the
6 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section
7 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
8 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this
9 state.

10 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
11 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
12 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
13 following description of the substance or subject matter of
14 the proposed constitutional amendment:

15 "Relating to Montgomery County, proposing an
16 amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to decrease
17 the terms of office for members elected after ratification of
18 this amendment from six to four years.

19 "Proposed by Act _____"

20 This description shall be followed by the following
21 language:

22 "Yes () No () ."
