PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Any provision of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, or amendments thereto, to the contrary notwithstanding, the Legislature by general or local law may provide for and authorize in Montgomery County the incorporation of a public corporation as a political subdivision of the state to be named the Montgomery County Reservoir Management Area Authority, for the development of that portion of Catoma Creek in Montgomery County and within the Montgomery County Reservoir Management Area, its tributaries, and watershed area, for the purposes of water conservation and supply, dam construction and reservoir development, industrial development, flood control, navigation, irrigation, public recreation, and related purposes. The law shall provide for the composition of the board of directors of the authority and specify the powers and duties of the authority and its board of directors; provide for the boundaries of the reservoir management area; authorize the authority to investigate the resources of the Montgomery County Reservoir Management Area, determine and implement the requirements for its full development and control, and carry out a unified comprehensive program of resource development, together with other powers, to effectuate the foregoing objective; authorize the authority to acquire land and interests in land by purchase, construction, lease, condemnation, or otherwise and to hold,

manage, and sell land and interests therein; make provisions respecting the establishment and revision of rates, fees, and charges for services rendered by the authority; provide for the issuance by the authority for any of its corporate purposes of interest-bearing revenue bonds and notes payable solely out of the revenues of the authority or out of the revenues of any particular facilities and other property of the authority, without regard to the specific facilities and other property with respect to which the bonds and notes may have been issued; provide for certain taxes; provide that the bonds and notes shall constitute negotiable instruments; provide that the bonds and notes may be secured by a pledge of the revenues from which they are payable, by contracts binding the authority for the proper application of its revenues and the proceeds of such bonds and notes and by a nonforeclosable mortgage or deed of trust or statutory mortgage lien on the facilities and other property out of the revenues from which the bonds and notes are payable; provide that bonds and notes of the authority may be issued under a trust indenture; provide for constructive notice of any statutory mortgage lien; authorize and make provisions respecting the assumption by the authority of obligations respecting facilities and other property acquired by the authority; provide for the use of the proceeds of bonds and notes issued by the authority and provide for the refunding by the issuance of bonds and notes of the authority of bonds and notes theretofore issued or obligations theretofore assumed by it; provide that bonds and

notes issued and contracts entered into by the authority pursuant to the act shall not constitute or create a debt of the state or of any county, municipality, or other political subdivision of the state; authorize the Montgomery County Commission and the municipalities located within Montgomery County to contribute money to the authority, without the necessity of an election and with or without consideration therefor; exempt from all taxation in this state, the authority, its property, corporate activities, income, revenues, bonds and notes, the income from its bonds and notes, and conveyances, leases, and mortgages and deeds of trust to which the authority is a party and exempt the authority from payment of certain charges to judges of probate; grant to the authority the power to levy and collect within the boundaries of the management area certain excise taxes, sales taxes, and ad valorem taxes; provide that the authority shall have zoning power within the boundaries of the management area; provide that the authority shall be exempt from regulation and supervision by the Public Service Commission and the state Department of Finance; provide for the use of public roads in the state by the authority; and provide for certain annual reports by the authority. Notwithstanding any other provision of this constitution, the Montgomery County Reservoir Management Area Authority may enter into contracts with and may accept grants from another authority organized pursuant to the laws of this state or federal laws and the contracts with or grants from another

1 authority, including, but not limited to, any other authority 2 authorized to issue general obligation bonds of this state, shall not constitute the extension of the state's credit in 3 violation of Amendment No. 58 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 93 of the Official 5 6 Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as 7 amended, or any other provision of this constitution or the laws of this state. 8 9 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 10 shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 11 12 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this 13 14 state. 15 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional 16 17 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of 18 the proposed constitutional amendment: 19 20 "Relating to Montgomery County, proposing an 21 amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to authorize the establishment of the Montgomery County Reservoir 22 23 Management Area Authority for the development of Catoma Creek 24 in Montgomery County.
