SYNOPSIS: This bill would define the term "persons" to include all humans from the moment of fertilization.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

To provide that the term "persons" as used in the Code of Alabama 1975, shall include all humans from the moment of fertilization.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The term "persons" as used in the Code of Alabama 1975, shall include any human being from the moment of fertilization or the functional equivalent thereof.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
