A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to Colbert County; to repeal Act 2009-733, 2009 Regular Session (Acts 2009, p. 2185), now appearing as Section 45-17-80.03, Code of Alabama 1975, providing for the assessment, collection, and distribution of solicitor's fees in certain criminal cases in the county; to provide that solicitor's fees shall continue to be assessed, collected, and distributed in Colbert County in certain criminal cases as provided by general law, pursuant to Act 2010-438, 2010 Regular Session (Acts 2010, p. 1074), now appearing as Section 12-19-182, Code of Alabama 1975.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Act 2009-733, 2009 Regular Session (Acts 2009, p. 2185), now appearing as Section 45-17-80.03, Code of Alabama 1975, providing for the assessment, collection, and distribution of solicitor's fees in certain criminal cases in

1 Colbert County, is repealed and solicitor's fees shall
2 continue to be collected and distributed in Colbert County,
3 pursuant to Section 12-19-182, Code of Alabama 1975.

4 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
5 first day of the third month following its passage and
6 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
