24	Montgomery County, respectively, there shall be assessed and
25	collected an additional court cost as follows:
26	(1) Four dollars (\$4) on each civil and criminal
27	case originating in the circuit court.

1 (2) Four dollars (\$4) on each civil and criminal case originating in the district court.

- (3) Two dollars (\$2) on each case originating in the Municipal Court of the City of Montgomery.
 - (b) The additional court costs collected pursuant to subsection (a) shall be collected in the same manner and at the same time as other court costs and shall be paid to the Montgomery County Law Library Fund by the 10th day of each month following collection. The money generated by the additional court cost may be expended for the maintenance, operation, and upkeep of the Montgomery County Law Library and for other expenses as determined necessary by the presiding circuit court judge to promote the efficient administration of justice.

Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
