13 Relating to Montgomery County; to provide for the
14 collection of an additional court cost on all cases in the
15 circuit, district, and municipal courts; and to provide for
16 distribution of the court costs to the Law Library Fund for
17 the maintenance, upkeep, and operation of the county law
18 library.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20 Section 1. This act shall apply only in Montgomery
21 County.

22 Section 2. (a) In addition to any court costs now
23 authorized in the circuit, district, and municipal courts in
24 Montgomery County, respectively, there shall be assessed and
25 collected an additional court cost as follows:

26 (1) Four dollars (\$4) on each civil and criminal
27 case originating in the circuit court.

1 (2) Four dollars (\$4) on each civil and criminal
2 case originating in the district court.

3 (3) Two dollars (\$2) on each case originating in the
4 Municipal Court of the City of Montgomery.

5 (b) The additional court costs collected pursuant to
6 subsection (a) shall be collected in the same manner and at
7 the same time as other court costs and shall be paid to the
8 Montgomery County Law Library Fund by the 10th day of each
9 month following collection. The money generated by the
10 additional court cost may be expended for the maintenance,
11 operation, and upkeep of the Montgomery County Law Library and
12 for other expenses as determined necessary by the presiding
13 circuit court judge to promote the efficient administration of
14 justice.

15 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
16 first day of the third month following its passage and
17 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
