A BILL

10 TO BE ENTITLED

11 AN ACT

13 Relating to Montgomery County; authorizing the
14 sheriff, upon approval by the Montgomery County Commission, to
15 establish and charge certain fees for certain services
16 rendered by the sheriff; to provide for the distribution of
17 the revenue; and to provide for the ratification of any prior
18 actions in compliance with this act.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20 Section 1. (a) The Sheriff of Montgomery County,
21 upon approval by the Montgomery County Commission, may
22 establish certain reasonable fees for services rendered by the
23 sheriff, including, but not limited to the following: Fees not
24 less than twenty-five dollars (\$25) for fingerprinting
25 persons; fees for making and providing copies of incident
26 reports; fees for making and providing, where authorized by
27 law, criminal history investigations and reports thereon; fees

for sending documents by facsimile or other transmission; fees for providing photographs and photocopies of photographs; and fees for copies of any other documents. The fingerprinting fee may not be charged for a law enforcement purpose on behalf of a law enforcement agency nor shall the fee apply to a person applying for a pistol permit.

(b) The sheriff shall remit the fees collected pursuant to this act monthly to the Montgomery County Commission for deposit in the county general fund.

(c) Any actions of the sheriff or his or her agents prior to the effective date of this act which are in compliance with this act are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
