SB339

With Notice and Proof

ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to Talladega County; providing for the assessment and collection of a solicitor's fee in civil cases payable to the Solicitor's Fund; and to provide for the distribution of the fee.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. In all civil cases in the Circuit and District courts in Talladega County, a docket fee, hereinafter referred to as a solicitor's fee, shall be assessed in each case. The solicitor's fee in civil cases shall be in the same amount as the docket fee or court cost which are assessed in civil circuit and district court cases in Talladega County and distributed to the Fair Trial Tax Fund. The fees shall be distributed monthly as follows: five dollars (\$5) from each case to the office of Circuit Clerk in Talladega County and the remainder of each fee to the solicitor's fund or district attorney's fund in the county where collected or to the fund in the county that may be hereafter prescribed by law for the solicitor's fee.

1 Section 2. The solicitor's fee may be expended by
2 the district attorney for the payment of any and all expenses
3 incurred or for any legitimate law enforcement purpose. That
4 portion of the fees earmarked for the Office of the Circuit
5 Clerk of Talladega County may be expended at the request of
6 the Circuit Clerk for any lawful purpose.

7 Section 3. This act shall become effective
8 immediately following its passage and approval by the
9 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
