6 ENROLLED, An Act,

7 Relating to Talladega County; providing for the  
8 assessment and collection of a solicitor's fee in civil cases  
9 payable to the Solicitor's Fund; and to provide for the  
10 distribution of the fee.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

12 Section 1. In all civil cases in the Circuit and  
13 District courts in Talladega County, a docket fee, hereinafter  
14 referred to as a solicitor's fee, shall be assessed in each  
15 case. The solicitor's fee in civil cases shall be in the same  
16 amount as the docket fee or court cost which are assessed in  
17 civil circuit and district court cases in Talladega County and  
18 distributed to the Fair Trial Tax Fund. The fees shall be  
19 distributed monthly as follows: five dollars (\$5) from each  
20 case to the office of Circuit Clerk in Talladega County and  
21 the remainder of each fee to the solicitor's fund or district  
22 attorney's fund in the county where collected or to the fund  
23 in the county that may be hereafter prescribed by law for the  
24 solicitor's fee.

Section 2. The solicitor's fee may be expended by the district attorney for the payment of any and all expenses incurred or for any legitimate law enforcement purpose. That portion of the fees earmarked for the Office of the Circuit Clerk of Talladega County may be expended at the request of the Circuit Clerk for any lawful purpose.

Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
