22	"Section 16. Each member of the county commission
23	may inspect the roads and bridges of his or her district from
24	time to time. The members of the county commission may also
25	assist in securing right-of-way and assist in public relations
26	generally. Each member of the county commission may elect to
27	direct a crew to maintain the unpaved roads in his or her

1 district and to address the complaints and concerns of the citizens of his or her district. The personnel and equipment 2 for any such crew shall be determined by the county commission 3 in session, and the expenses for any crew shall come out of the overall budget for the construction, maintenance, and 5 6 repairs of the county roads, bridges, and ferries of Macon 7 County. Any commissioner electing to direct a crew will be the custodian and accountable to the county commission for all 8 road machinery, equipment, tools, supplies, and repair parts 9 10 owned by Macon County and used by his or her crew. The county commission shall establish necessary policies and regulations 11 12 governing accountability for the county owned equipment. 13 Request for requisitions for all materials, machinery, 14 equipment, and supplies necessary for the operation of any 15 crew shall be routed through the county engineer, or presented to the commission in session." 16

Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict with this act are repealed.
