1 All moneys paid to the Forever Wild Land Trust pursuant to Section 7 of Amendment 543 of the Constitution of 2 Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 7 of Section 219.07 3 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, shall continue to be paid for a 20-year 5 6 period beginning with the 2012-2013 fiscal year and ending in 7 the fiscal year 2031-2032. Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 8 shall be held at the next statewide election and shall be held 9 10 in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 and 285 of the 11 12 Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, 13 as amended, and the election laws of this state. 14 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 15 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 16 17 following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment: 18 "Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of 19 Alabama of 1901, relating to the Forever Wild Land Trust, to 20 21 extend payments made to the Land Trust for a 20-year period. 22 "Proposed by Act ."
