23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
24	Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this section, a
25	private entity is an entity that is not supported by public
26	funds and includes, but is not limited to, the Alabama High
27	School Athletic Association.

(b) A public K-12 school may not maintain membership in any private entity that may attempt to levy or collect a monetary fine against a member school. This subsection shall apply regardless of whether the private entity collects membership dues and regardless of whether the potential fines the private entity may attempt to levy against a member school are based on actions taken by the member school or an employee or student of the school of the applicable local board of education.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
