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2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of
4 Alabama of 1901, pertaining only to Montgomery County; to
5 decrease the term of office of members of the board from six
6 to four years.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. The following amendment to the
9 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become
10 valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of
11 this act are fulfilled:

12 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

13 As terms of office on the Montgomery County Board of
14 Education expire, new members shall be elected to the board
15 for terms of four years.

16 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
17 shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the
18 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section
19 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
20 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this
21 state.

22 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
23 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
24 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the

1 following description of the substance or subject matter of
2 the proposed constitutional amendment:

3 "Relating to Montgomery County, proposing an
4 amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to decrease
5 the terms of office for members elected after ratification of
6 this amendment from six to four years.

7 "Proposed by Act _____"

8 This description shall be followed by the following
9 language:

10 "Yes () No ()."
