21	Section 1. Section 12 of Act 387 of the 1965 Regular
22	Session (Acts 1965, p. 522), is amended to read as follows:
23	"Section 12. Distribution of Taxes. All taxes
24	required to be paid by this act to the Commissioner of
25	Licenses shall be received by him and shall be distributed by
26	him on or before the 10th day of the month following his
27	receipt of same as follows: (1) One percent (1%) of the taxes

collected shall first be paid by the Commissioner of Licenses
into the general treasury of the county for the collection of
the taxes and the enforcement and administration of this act.

(2) The remainder of said tax shall be paid by the
Commissioner of Licenses into the County Indigent Care Fund
established by Section 13 of this act.

"The proceeds from the taxes levied by this act
shall be paid into the county general fund as received and may

shall be paid into the county general fund as received and may be expended for county public purposes in the manner as the governing body of the county shall determine, except to the extent that the proceeds are pledged to debt repayment or the contractual obligations of the county."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
