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A BILL

TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

Relating to Jefferson County; to provide limited authority for the county commission of said county, subject to any otherwise applicable limitation or provisions of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901 or of any general law of the state; to levy, assess, and collect in Jefferson County taxes in addition to those heretofore levied for the benefit of the county, including but not limited to, sales and use taxes parallel to the levies and assessments of the sales and use taxes heretofore authorized to be levied by the county, lease and rental taxes, other excise taxes, alcoholic beverage taxes, and privilege license taxes, which such additional taxes shall be estimated to produce additional county revenues not in excess of such amounts for such periods as shall be provided for in the act; to provide for the reduction or other adjustment of the rate or rates of such additional taxes by

the county commission in certain circumstances; to provide that the proceeds of the taxes so authorized to be levied, assessed, and collected shall be deposited into the county general fund to be used either in the manner determined by the county commission or, in certain cases, if said revenues shall exceed the previously estimated amounts thereof, for payment of principal and interest coming due on the general obligation indebtedness of the county; to require that, before the levy, assessment, and collection of any such additional tax may commence, the county commission shall adopt an ordinance providing for the same with the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the members thereof, which ordinance shall be posted on the county's website for a stated period of time prior to its consideration for adoption at a meeting of said county commission; to require the county commission to hold a public hearing on the proposed ordinance prior to the adoption thereof; to provide for a limited period of time during which under the act the county commission shall have the authority to adopt any such ordinance and thereby commence the levy of any such additional tax or taxes; to provide that the provisions of the act shall be cumulative and supplemental to any and all other laws or parts of laws relating to the county; to repeal laws in conflict therewith; to provide for the severability of the act; and to provide for an effective date.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) Subject to any limitation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901 or of any general law of this state, the Jefferson County Commission shall have the power to levy, assess, and collect additional taxes, including but not limited to, sales and use taxes parallel to the levies and assessments of the sales and use taxes heretofore authorized to be levied by the county, lease and rental taxes, excise taxes, alcoholic beverage taxes, and privilege license taxes.

- (b) It is the intent of the Legislature that the said county commission shall use its best efforts to limit, by setting the applicable rate or rates, the revenue collected from all such additional taxes levied to an amount estimated to be equal to or less than the Revenue Target. For purposes of this act, "Revenue Target" shall mean \$50,000,000 for the first full fiscal year of the county during which any such additional taxes are levied, if at the time of such levy the Legislature has not authorized a new Jefferson County business license tax, or \$43,000,000, if the Legislature has authorized a new Jefferson County business levying and collecting such tax.
- (c) If the net revenues collected by the county from all such additional taxes levied pursuant to the authority herein contained for the first full fiscal year of the county during which any of such taxes herein authorized are levied exceeds the Revenue Target plus five percent thereof, the excess amount shall be used exclusively to pay debt service on, or to refund or retire, such general obligation

indebtedness of the county as shall then be outstanding; provided further, that in such event the county commission shall, as soon as practical following the close of such first full fiscal year, adopt an ordinance adjusting the rate or rates of some or all of the additional taxes herein authorized and levied during such first fiscal year so that the net revenue from all such additional taxes, had such rate or rates been in effect, would be equal to or less than the Revenue Target plus five percent thereof during the first full fiscal year, but no further transfers of any excess revenue over said estimated amount for that or any other subsequent fiscal year of the county shall be required. It is the intent of the Legislature that any excess amounts collected by the county from any taxes herein authorized to be levied after the initial fiscal year of such levies shall inure to the benefit of the general fund of the county.

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- (d) The county commission is authorized to adopt any ordinances necessary to levy, assess, and collect any additional taxes authorized herein. Provided further, that in order for any additional taxes to be levied, assessed, and collected pursuant to this act, the county commission shall adopt an ordinance to such effect with the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the members of the entire county commission.
- (e) Before the county commission may adopt an ordinance for any additional taxes to be levied, assessed, and collected pursuant to this act, the county commission shall

(i) post the text of the proposed ordinance on the county's public website for a period of not less than fifteen (15) days and (ii) hold a public hearing thereafter on such proposed ordinance, with public notice thereof being given not less than fifteen (15) days prior to said public hearing. Such notice shall be posted in a public and conspicuous location in the courthouse and in other public buildings determined appropriate by the county commission and shall be forwarded to all local news media that have on file with the county commission a written request for notification of the schedule of meetings of the county commission.

Section 2. The provisions of this act are severable. If any part of this act is declared invalid or unconstitutional, that declaration shall not affect the part which remains.

Section 3. The provisions of this act shall be cumulative to any and all other laws or parts of laws relating to Jefferson County, except that those in conflict with the provisions of this act are specifically repealed.

Section 4. The authority of the county commission herein to levy additional taxes shall terminate at midnight on November 5, 2014, unless such authority is explicitly extended by a duly enacted act of the Legislature; provided, said termination of the authority to thereafter to levy such additional taxes shall not in any manner limit the authority of the county commission to continue to levy, collect, and administer the additional taxes initially levied prior to

November 5, 2014, pursuant to the authority herein contained, 1 2 and provided further that the termination of authority to levy additional taxes hereinabove provided for shall not be 3 construed as a repeal of this act or the abrogation of the authority of the county commission to continue the levy and 5 collection of such additional taxes as shall have theretofore 6 been levied in accordance with the provisions of this act. 7 Section 5. This act shall become effective 8 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or 9 10 its otherwise becoming law.
