- appointed to hold the election in the manner provided by law for holding other county elections and the returns thereof tabulated and results certified as provided by law for such county elections. The election shall be held at the same time of the primary, general, or countywide election, next succeeding the date of filing the petition. The election shall not be held within less than 30 days nor, except as herein provided, more than 45 days from the date of the proposed diversion.
- (c) Notice of the election shall be given by the judge of probate by publication at least three weeks before the date of election in a newspaper in the county and by posting the notice at the courthouse apprising the voters of the county that an election shall be held to determine whether county tax proceeds that are currently pledged for the support of indigent health care should be diverted to other uses.
- (d) The cost of the election, including cost of notice by publication, shall be paid out of the general fund of the county.
- (e) Only qualified voters shall vote in the election. If a majority of the voters vote "Yes," then the

county tax proceeds that are currently pledged for the support of indigent health care may be diverted to other uses.

Section 4. All laws or parts of laws which conflict with this act are repealed.

Section 5. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the

Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.

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
