10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT
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13 Relating to Jackson County; to provide for the
14 distribution of T.V.A. in-lieu-of-taxes payments; and to
15 repeal Act 79-473, 1979 Regular Session (Acts 1979, p. 873)
16 and Act 99-550, 1999 Regular Session (Acts 1999, p. 1194).
17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

18 Section 1. (a) All payments to Jackson County after
19 the effective date of this act shall be distributed as
20 follows:

21 (1) Four percent to equip and maintain the Jackson
22 County Legislative Delegation Office for the members of the
23 state legislative delegation serving Jackson County.

24 (2) Thirty-nine and two-thirds percent to the public
25 school systems in the county on a per pupil basis.

1 (3) Twenty-nine and two-thirds percent to the
2 incorporated municipalities in the county on a population
3 basis.

4 (4) Twenty-five and two-thirds percent to the
5 general fund of the county to be disbursed at the direction of
6 the committee created pursuant to Section 2.

7 (b) All growth in T.V.A. in-lieu-of-taxes payments
8 received since October 1999, by the county over the previous
9 year's payments disbursed pursuant to Act 79-473 and Act
10 99-550 which have not been distributed on the effective date
11 of this act shall be paid into a contingency fund in the
12 county treasury and disbursed at the direction of the
13 committee created pursuant to Section 2.

14 Section 2. (a) A Discretionary Fund Committee is
15 established for the purpose of distributing the T.V.A.
16 in-lieu-of-taxes payments disbursed to Jackson County. The
17 committee shall be comprised of the following members:

18 (1) Two members who are residents of Jackson County
19 appointed by the senator representing Jackson County.

20 (2) One member appointed by each of the House of
21 Representatives members representing Jackson County. Each of
22 these members shall be a resident of the legislative district
23 of the respective appointing house member.

24 (b) The terms of the members of the committee shall
25 run concurrently with the legislative term of the appointing
26 authority.

27 Section 3. Acts 79-473 and 99-550 are repealed.

1 Section 4. This act shall become effective
2 immediately following its passage and approval by the
3 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
