3 Relating to Colbert County; to repeal Act 2009-733,
4 2009 Regular Session (Acts 2009, p. 2185), now appearing as
5 Section 45-17-80.03, Code of Alabama 1975, providing for the
6 assessment, collection, and distribution of solicitor's fees
7 in certain criminal cases in the county; to provide that
8 solicitor's fees shall continue to be assessed, collected, and
9 distributed in Colbert County in certain criminal cases as
10 provided by general law, pursuant to Act 2010-438, 2010
11 Regular Session (Acts 2010, p. 1074), now appearing as Section
12 12-19-182, Code of Alabama 1975.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

14 Section 1. Act 2009-733, 2009 Regular Session (Acts
15 2009, p. 2185), now appearing as Section 45-17-80.03, Code of
16 Alabama 1975, providing for the assessment, collection, and
17 distribution of solicitor's fees in certain criminal cases in
18 Colbert County, is repealed and solicitor's fees shall
19 continue to be collected and distributed in Colbert County,
20 pursuant to Section 12-19-182, Code of Alabama 1975.

21 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
22 first day of the third month following its passage and
23 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
