12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
13	Section 1. Section 45-17-233 of the Code of Alabama
14	1975, is amended to read as follows:
15	" §45-17-233.
16	"In Colbert County, the fee for issuance of a permit
17	to carry a pistol in a vehicle or concealed on or about the
18	person shall be five dollars (\$5) which shall be collected by
19	the sheriff and deposited in any bank located in Colbert
20	County selected by the sheriff, into a fund known as the
21	Sheriff's Special Fund. Ninety percent of each fee collected
22	shall be credited to the Sheriff's Special Fund. The fees may
23	be drawn on and used at the sole discretion of the sheriff for
24	law enforcement purposes and the operation of his or her
25	office, including, but not limited to, the purchase of
26	equipment, uniforms, materials, and supplies. Ten percent of
27	each fee collected by the sheriff shall be paid into the

general fund of the county and shall be used as other general

fund monies are expended. The establishment of the Sheriff's

Special Fund as provided for in this section and the use of

the funds shall in no way diminish or otherwise affect any

other appropriation or funds now or hereinafter provided for

by law for the operation of the office of the sheriff.

"(a) In Colbert County, the fee for the issuance of a permit to carry a pistol as provided in Section 13A-11-75,

Code of Alabama 1975, shall be fifteen dollars (\$15), except for persons age 60 and over, the fee shall be five dollars (\$5).

"(b) Each fee collected pursuant to this act shall be deposited by the sheriff in any bank located in the county into a fund known as the sheriff's law enforcement pistol permits fund. One dollar (\$1) from each fee shall be distributed on a regular basis to the county general fund. The remainder of the fund may be drawn upon by the sheriff or his or her duly authorized agent and shall be used exclusively for law enforcement purposes."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
