ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to Marshall County; to provide for the distribution of additional TVA in-lieu-of taxes payments received by the county pursuant to Act 2010-135, to the school systems in the county and as provided by a committee appointed for that purpose.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) The increase in TVA in-lieu-of taxes payments to Marshall County generated by Act 2010-135, 2010 Regular Session, to the counties served by the TVA shall be distributed as follows:

(1) Twenty-five percent of the total amount to the Marshall County Board of Education, the Arab City Board of Education, the Guntersville City Board of Education, the Albertville City Board of Education, and the Boaz City Board of Education, on a per pupil basis based upon the student enrollment of the respective school systems on the last day of the first monthly attendance report of each school year.

(2) Seventy-five percent to a county discretionary fund. Moneys in the discretionary fund may be expended for any

1 lawful purpose by warrant drawn upon the fund pursuant to the
2 direction of a discretionary fund committee.

3 (b) The Discretionary Fund Committee is created. The
4 committee shall be comprised of three members as follows:

5 (1) One member who is a resident of Marshall County,
6 to be appointed by the state Senator representing Marshall
7 County.

8 (2) Two members, one to be appointed by each of the
9 members of the House of Representatives representing Marshall
10 County. Each of these members shall be a resident of the
11 legislative district of the respective appointing house
12 member.

13 (3) The term of each member of the discretionary
14 fund committee shall run concurrently with the terms of the
15 legislator appointing that member. The members of the
16 committee may be reappointed to additional terms.

17 (c) The distributions made pursuant to this act
18 shall be made separate and apart from all other TVA in-lieu-of
19 taxes payments required by Marshall County, including, but not
20 limited to, those payments distributed pursuant to Act
21 2007-498, 2007 Regular Session.

22 Section 2. This act shall become effective
23 immediately following its passage and approval by the
24 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
