SB252

ENROLLED, An Act,

To amend Section 32-2-84, Code of Alabama 1975, to provide that funds transferred from the Public Road and Bridge Fund of the Department of Transportation to the Department of Public Safety pursuant to Act 91-797 may be expended for the operations of the Department of Public Safety for fiscal years ending September 30, 2012, 2013, and 2014.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 32-2-84 is amended to read as follows:

"§32-2-84.

The funds designated by this article to be deposited to the Motor Vehicle Replacement Fund are intended to be in addition to the amounts transferred annually to the Department of Public Safety from the Public Road and Bridge Fund pursuant to Act 91-797. For fiscal years ending September 30, 2011, 2012, 2013, and 2014, funds transferred to the Department of Public Safety pursuant to Act 91-797 may be expended for the operations of the department. Effective October 1, 2014, funds transferred to the Department of Public Safety pursuant to Act 91-797 shall be expended for the purchase of equipment for traffic law enforcement, as provided by that act. Such

1 equipment shall include motor vehicles and related equipment
2 only.

3 Section 2. The provisions of this act are severable.
4 If any part of this act is declared invalid or
5 unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the part
6 that remains.

7 Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
8 with this act are hereby repealed.

9 Section 4. This bill shall become effective
10 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor or
11 upon its otherwise becoming a law.
