8 2009-611, 2009 Regular Session (Acts 2009, p. 1774), providing
9 for the assessment, collection, and distribution of the
10 solicitor's fee in certain criminal cases in the county; and
11 to provide that the solicitor's fee shall continue to be
12 assessed, collected, and distributed in Lauderdale County as
13 provided by general law.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

15 Section 1. Act 2009-611, 2009 Regular Session (Acts
16 2009, p. 1774), providing for the assessment, collection, and
17 distribution of the solicitor's fee in certain criminal cases
18 in Lauderdale County, is repealed. A solicitor's fee shall
19 continue to be collected in Lauderdale County, pursuant to
20 Section 12-19-182, Code of Alabama 1975.

21 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
22 first day of the third month following its passage and
23 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
