2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 To authorize a city or county to install a deaf or  
4 blind child area sign on a residential road or street.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

6 Section 1. (a) Upon request, a city or county may  
7 install a deaf or blind child area sign to warn drivers in the  
8 area that a deaf or blind child resides on a residential road  
9 or street.

10 (b) The cost of the sign may be paid by the  
11 requesting party, a private individual, or a neighborhood  
12 association.

13 (c) The county or city shall review annually the  
14 placement of a sign that has been installed pursuant to this  
15 section to ensure that the placement is still applicable.

16 Section 2. This act shall be known as the "Ian  
17 Langston Worley Oliver Act."

18 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the  
19 first day of the third month following its passage and  
20 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
