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2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 Relating to Macon County; to amend Section 16 of Act
4 97-663, 1997 Regular Session (Acts 1997, p. 1272), as amended
5 by Act 2010-525; to further provide for the duties of the
6 members of the county commission related to roads and bridges
7 in the county.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. Section 16 of Act 97-663, 1997 Regular
10 Session (Acts 1997, p. 1272), as amended by Act 2010-525, is
11 further amended to read as follows:

12 "Section 16. Each member of the county commission
13 may inspect the roads and bridges of his or her district from
14 time to time. The members of the county commission may also
15 assist in securing right-of-way and assist in public relations
16 generally. Each member of the county commission may elect to
17 direct a crew to maintain the unpaved roads in his or her
18 district and to address the complaints and concerns of the
19 citizens of his or her district. The personnel and equipment
20 for any such crew shall be determined by the county commission
21 in session, and the expenses for any crew shall come out of
22 the overall budget for the construction, maintenance, and
23 repairs of the county roads, bridges, and ferries of Macon
24 County. Any commissioner electing to direct a crew will be the
25 custodian and accountable to the county commission for all

1 road machinery, equipment, tools, supplies, and repair parts
2 owned by Macon County and used by his or her crew. The county
3 commission shall establish necessary policies and regulations
4 governing accountability for the county owned equipment.
5 Request for requisitions for all materials, machinery,
6 equipment, and supplies necessary for the operation of any
7 crew shall be routed through the county engineer, or presented
8 to the commission in session."

9 Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
10 with this act are repealed.

11 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
12 first day of the third month following its passage and
13 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
