Relating to Coffee County; providing further for the use of certain funds accruing to the Sheriff's Work Release Fund.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The Sheriff of Coffee County, in his or her discretion, may expend funds accruing to the Sheriff's Work Release Fund for the betterment of law enforcement in Coffee County that is in the interest of the public and in the discharge of the sheriff's office as the sheriff sees fit.

Section 2. (a) The sheriff shall establish and maintain a Sheriff's Work Release Fund in a bank located in Coffee County. All funds received under this act shall be deposited by the sheriff into the Sheriff's Work Release Fund.

(b) The sheriff shall keep an account of all funds in the Sheriff's Work Release Fund for audit by the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts. The Sheriff's Work Release Fund shall be audited at the same time other accounts of the sheriff are audited. The Department of Examiners of Public Accounts shall submit a copy of the audit to the sheriff within 30 days of its completion.

Section 3. Any and all monies on the effective date of this act in the current Work Release Fund shall be
