2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 Relating to Coffee County; providing further for the
4 use of certain funds accruing to the Sheriff's Work Release
5 Fund.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

7 Section 1. The Sheriff of Coffee County, in his or
8 her discretion, may expend funds accruing to the Sheriff's
9 Work Release Fund for the betterment of law enforcement in
10 Coffee County that is in the interest of the public and in the
11 discharge of the sheriff's office as the sheriff sees fit.

12 Section 2. (a) The sheriff shall establish and
13 maintain a Sheriff's Work Release Fund in a bank located in
14 Coffee County. All funds received under this act shall be
15 deposited by the sheriff into the Sheriff's Work Release Fund.

16 (b) The sheriff shall keep an account of all funds
17 in the Sheriff's Work Release Fund for audit by the Department
18 of Examiners of Public Accounts. The Sheriff's Work Release
19 Fund shall be audited at the same time other accounts of the
20 sheriff are audited. The Department of Examiners of Public
21 Accounts shall submit a copy of the audit to the sheriff
22 within 30 days of its completion.

23 Section 3. Any and all monies on the effective date
24 of this act in the current Work Release Fund shall be

1 transferred into the Sheriff's Work Release Fund created by
2 this act.

3 Section 4. The provisions of this act are severable.
4 If any part of this act is declared invalid or
5 unconstitutional, that declaration shall not affect the part
6 which remains.

7 Section 5. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
8 with this act are repealed.

9 Section 6. This act shall become effective
10 immediately following its passage and approval by the
11 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
