8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, termination dates are  
9 established for enumerated state agencies. The  
10 agencies are periodically reviewed by the Alabama  
11 Sunset Committee. After the review process is  
12 completed, the committee prepares its  
13 recommendations for the agencies to the Legislature  
14 in the form of sunset bills which either continue,  
15 terminate, or continue with modification each  
16 agency reviewed.

17 This bill would provide for the continuance  
18 of the Commercial Mobile Radio Service (CRMS) Board  
19 until October 1, 2014.

1           Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the  
2           existence and functioning of the Commercial Mobile Radio  
3           Service (CRMS) Board until October 1, 2014.

4           BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

5           Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the  
6           Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Commercial  
7           Mobile Radio Service (CRMS) Board until October 1, 2014.

8           Section 2. The existence and functioning of the  
9           Commercial Mobile Radio Service (CRMS) Board, created and  
10          functioning pursuant to Sections 11-98-6 to 11-98-12,  
11          inclusive, Code of Alabama 1975, is continued until October 1,  
12          2014, and those code sections are expressly preserved.

13          Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the  
14          recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in  
15          Sections 1 and 2.

16          Section 4. This act shall become effective  
17          immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or  
18          its otherwise becoming law.
