| 20 | Section 1. (a) In Dale County, the fee for the                |

| 23 | 13A-11-75, Code of Alabama 1975, shall be twenty dollars      |
| 24 | (\$20), which shall be collected by the sheriff or his or her |
| 25 | designated agent.   |

1 (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), the fee for
2 issuing a pistol permit to a person aged 65 or older shall be
3 ten dollars (\$10).

- Section 2. (a) All funds collected under Section 1 shall be deposited by the Sheriff of Dale County, or his or her designated agent, in any bank located in Dale County and selected by the sheriff, into a fund known as the Sheriff's Law Enforcement Fund.
- (b) The Sheriff's Law Enforcement Fund provided in subsection (a) shall be drawn upon by the Sheriff of Dale County, or his or her designated agent, and shall be exclusively for law enforcement purposes in the interest of the public and in the discharge of the duties of the office of the sheriff as the sheriff sees fit.
- (c) The establishment of the Sheriff's Law
  Enforcement Fund as provided in this section and the use of
  such funds shall in no way diminish or take the place of any
  other imbursement or other source of income established for
  the sheriff or the operation of the office.
- Section 3. Act 85-608, 1985 Regular Session (Acts 1985, p. 943), is repealed and all laws or parts of law which conflict with this act are repealed.
- Section 4. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
