10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT
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13 Relating to Dale County; to provide a fee for the
14 issuance of pistol permits in Dale County; to provide for the
15 deposit of the fees into the Sheriff's Law Enforcement Fund;
16 to provide for the use of the fund; and to repeal Act 85-608,
17 1985 Regular Session (Acts 1985, p. 943), relating to the
18 pistol permit fee.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20 Section 1. (a) In Dale County, the fee for the
21 issuance of a permit to carry a pistol in a vehicle or
22 concealed on or about the person as provided in Title
23 13A-11-75, Code of Alabama 1975, shall be twenty dollars
24 (\$20), which shall be collected by the sheriff or his or her
25 designated agent.

1 (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), the fee for
2 issuing a pistol permit to a person aged 65 or older shall be
3 ten dollars (\$10).

4 Section 2. (a) All funds collected under Section 1
5 shall be deposited by the Sheriff of Dale County, or his or
6 her designated agent, in any bank located in Dale County and
7 selected by the sheriff, into a fund known as the Sheriff's
8 Law Enforcement Fund.

9 (b) The Sheriff's Law Enforcement Fund provided in
10 subsection (a) shall be drawn upon by the Sheriff of Dale
11 County, or his or her designated agent, and shall be
12 exclusively for law enforcement purposes in the interest of
13 the public and in the discharge of the duties of the office of
14 the sheriff as the sheriff sees fit.

15 (c) The establishment of the Sheriff's Law
16 Enforcement Fund as provided in this section and the use of
17 such funds shall in no way diminish or take the place of any
18 other imbursement or other source of income established for
19 the sheriff or the operation of the office.

20 Section 3. Act 85-608, 1985 Regular Session (Acts
21 1985, p. 943), is repealed and all laws or parts of law which
22 conflict with this act are repealed.

23 Section 4. This act shall become effective on the
24 first day of the third month following its passage and
25 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
