BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

7 Section 1. The following amendment to the

8 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become

valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of

this act are fulfilled:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Amendment No. 846 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 1.50, Jackson County, Local Constitutional Amendments of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, relating to special elections to fill vacancies in county offices, is repealed.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:

"Proposing a local constitutional amendment relating 1 to Jackson County, to repeal Amendment No. 846 of the 2 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 3 1.50, Jackson County, Local Constitutional Amendments of the 5 Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, relating to special elections to fill vacancies 6 7 occurring in county offices. "Proposed by Act ." 8 This description shall be followed by the following 9 10 language: "Yes () No ()." 11
