A BILL

10 TO BE ENTITLED

11 AN ACT

12

13 Relating to Mobile County; to establish the
14 solicitor's fund as a separate fund under the direction and
15 control of the District Attorney of the Thirtieth Judicial
16 Circuit; to provide for the deposit into the fund of all fees
17 taxed as solicitor's fees; to authorize the district attorney
18 to expend the fees in the fund; and to repeal Act 100, 1955
19 Regular Session (Acts 1955, p. 344) creating a solicitor's
20 fund and authorizing expenditure of the fees and in the fund
21 upon requisition on the county treasury.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

23 Section 1. (a) The solicitor's fund shall be
24 established as a separate fund in any bank in the county which
25 is an approved depository for public funds. All fees
26 heretofore or hereafter taxed as solicitor's fees and
27 collected as part of the court costs in the courts of the

Thirtieth Judicial Circuit shall be deposited into the solicitor's fund.

(b) The moneys in the solicitor's fund shall be payable upon order of the District Attorney of the Thirtieth Judicial Circuit by check signed by the district attorney in his or her official capacity for the payment of any and all expenses incurred by the district attorney for law enforcement purposes and in the discharge of the duties of his or her office or as otherwise authorized by law.

Section 2. Act 100, 1955 Regular Session (Acts 1955, p. 344), is repealed.

Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
