11 AN ACT
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13 Relating to Macon County; to amend Section 1 of Act
14 2009-347 of the 2009 Regular Session (Acts 2009, p. 670), to
15 further provide for the distribution of the solicitor's fee.
16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. Section 1 of Act 2009-347 of the 2009
18 Regular Session (Acts 2009, p. 670), is amended to read as
19 follows:

20 "Section 1. In all juvenile, traffic, criminal, and
21 quasi-criminal cases in the juvenile, district, circuit, and
22 municipal courts in Macon County, a docket fee, hereinafter
23 referred to as a solicitor's fee, shall be assessed in each
24 case. The fees, when collected, shall be distributed monthly
25 as follows: Three dollars (\$3) of the fee assessed in each
26 case shall be distributed to the Macon County Circuit Clerk
27 for operation of the office of the circuit clerk, three

1 dollars (\$3) of the fees assessed in each case prosecuted in
2 the Notasulga Municipal Court shall be distributed by the
3 municipal court to the Town of Notasulga to be used by the
4 town for payment of expenses incurred by the town for training
5 and continuing education expenses for the Notasulga Municipal
6 Court Clerk and Magistrate, and the remainder of any fees
7 shall be distributed to the Solicitor's Fund or District
8 Attorney's Fund in the county where the fee is collected or to
9 the fund that may be hereafter prescribed by law for the
10 solicitor's fee, and such funds shall be expended in Macon
11 County. The solicitor's fee shall be in an amount equal to all
12 docket fees or court costs which are assessed upon an
13 adjudication of guilt in a criminal case and distributed to
14 the Fair Trial Tax Fund."

15 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
16 first day of the third month following its passage and
17 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
