10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT
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13 Relating to Shelby County; to provide for the speed
14 limit and the setting of speed limits on county roads in a
15 platted subdivision or development in the unincorporated areas
16 of the county; and to specify that violations would be subject
17 to existing penalties provided by law.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

19 Section 1. In Shelby County, in the unincorporated
20 areas of the county, within a platted residential subdivision,
21 a platted manufactured home community whether the lots are
22 rented or sold, a platted condominium development, or any
23 other platted subdivision or development subject to the
24 approval or development control by the Shelby County Planning
25 Commission where interior road improvements are required, the
26 speed limit on any county road or other road within the
27 subdivision or development shall be 25 miles per hour unless a

1 different speed limit is set based on engineering design or an
2 engineering study approved by the Shelby County Engineer. Any
3 violation of any speed limit set pursuant to this act shall be
4 a traffic offense subject to penalties in the same manner as
5 otherwise provided by law.

6 Section 2. This act is adopted pursuant to Amendment
7 707 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as
8 Section 3, Shelby County Local Amendments, Official
9 ReCompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as
10 amended.

11 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
12 first day of the third month following its passage and
13 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
