13 Relating to Russell County; providing for an  
14 additional expense allowance and salary for the revenue  
15 commissioner.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. Commencing on the first day of the month  
18 immediately following the effective date of this act, the  
19 Revenue Commissioner of Russell County shall receive an  
20 additional expense allowance in the amount of ten thousand  
21 dollars (\$10,000) per annum, which shall be in addition to all  
22 other expense allowances, compensation, or salary provided by  
23 law. Payment of this expense allowance shall be prorated and  
24 payable in the same manner and from the same funds as the  
25 salary the revenue commissioner is receiving on the effective  
26 date of this act. The expense allowance provided by this act  
27 shall be treated in the same manner as salary for the purposes

1 of retirement benefits, and the same percentage contribution  
2 shall be deducted from the expense allowance and paid into the  
3 retirement program for ad valorem tax officials as is deducted  
4 from the salary of the revenue commissioner.

5 Section 2. Beginning with the expiration of the term  
6 of the incumbent revenue commissioner, the annual salary for  
7 the revenue commissioner shall be increased by ten thousand  
8 dollars (\$10,000) per annum, and, at that time, Section 1  
9 shall become null and void.

10 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the  
11 first day of the third month following its passage and  
12 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
