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9 A BILL  
10 TO BE ENTITLED  
11 AN ACT  
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13 Relating to Morgan County; to provide for the  
14 allocation and expenditure of money received from the  
15 Tennessee Valley Authority and distributed to Morgan County  
16 pursuant to Act 2010-135, 2010 Regular Session (Acts 2010, p.  
17 190), for the fiscal years 2014, 2015, and 2016.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

19 Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of  
20 law, after the allocation of the proceeds pursuant to House  
21 Bill 271 of the 2013 Regular Session, any remaining proceeds  
22 allocated to Morgan County pursuant to Act 2010-135, 2010  
23 Regular Session (Acts 2010, p. 190), from the in-lieu-of-taxes  
24 payments made by the Tennessee Valley Authority for fiscal  
25 years 2014, 2015, and 2016 shall be distributed as follows:

1           (1) Two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) each  
2 year to the City of Hartselle for lighting at the municipal  
3 soccer fields in the City of Hartselle.

4           (2) One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) each  
5 year to the United Way of Morgan County for the sole purpose  
6 of funding the Starting Strong Pre-K Initiative for a  
7 countywide Pre-K program.

8           (3) Three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) each  
9 year to the City of Decatur for capital improvements to Jack  
10 Allen Park.

11           (4) Two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) each  
12 year to the Morgan County Commission for capital improvements  
13 in the four primary county recreational parks and in senior  
14 centers, whether or not located in unincorporated portions of  
15 Morgan County or in the city limits of any municipality  
16 thereof, to be administered and disbursed by the county  
17 commission after consultation with the county legislative  
18 delegation.

19           (5) In the event that there are not sufficient funds  
20 to make the full amount of distributions above, those  
21 distribution amounts shall be distributed proportionately.

22           (6) Upon the payment of the above distributions, any  
23 remainder shall be distributed each year to the City of  
24 Decatur for capital improvements in Jack Allen Park.

25           Section 2. This act shall become effective  
26 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
27 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
