5 TO BE ENTITLED  
6 AN ACT  
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8 Relating to Morgan County; to provide for the  
9 allocation and expenditure of money received from the  
10 Tennessee Valley Authority and distributed to Morgan County  
11 pursuant to Act 2010-135, 2010 Regular Session (Acts 2010, p.  
12 190), for the fiscal years 2014, 2015, and 2016.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

14 Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of  
15 law, after the allocation of the proceeds pursuant to House  
16 Bill 271 of the 2013 Regular Session, any remaining proceeds  
17 allocated to Morgan County pursuant to Act 2010-135, 2010  
18 Regular Session (Acts 2010, p. 190), from the in-lieu-of-taxes  
19 payments made by the Tennessee Valley Authority for fiscal  
20 years 2014, 2015, and 2016 shall be distributed as follows:

21 (1) ~~Two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000)~~ One  
22 hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$175,000) each year to  
23 the City of Hartselle for lighting at the municipal soccer  
24 fields in the City of Hartselle.

25 (2) One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) each  
26 year to the United Way of Morgan County for the sole purpose

1 of funding the Starting Strong Pre-K Initiative for a  
2 countywide Pre-K program.

3 ~~(3) Three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000)~~ Two  
4 hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$275,000) each year to  
5 the City of Decatur for capital improvements to Jack Allen  
6 Park.

7 (4) Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) each year to  
8 the City of Priceville for the funding of the sewer system and  
9 the veteran's park.

10 ~~(4)~~ (5) Two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) each  
11 year to the Morgan County Commission for capital improvements  
12 in the four primary county recreational parks and in senior  
13 centers, whether or not located in unincorporated portions of  
14 Morgan County or in the city limits of any municipality  
15 thereof, to be administered and disbursed by the county  
16 commission after consultation with the county legislative  
17 delegation.

18 ~~(5)~~ (6) In the event that there are not sufficient  
19 funds to make the full amount of distributions above, those  
20 distribution amounts shall be distributed proportionately.

21 ~~(6)~~ (7) Upon the payment of the above distributions,  
22 any remainder shall be distributed each year to the City of  
23 Decatur for capital improvements in Jack Allen Park.

24 Section 2. This act shall become effective  
25 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
26 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
