13 Relating to the City of Midfield in Jefferson  
14 County; authorizing the city governing body to levy an  
15 additional ad valorem tax and providing for a referendum.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. Pursuant to subsection (f) of Amendment  
18 No. 373 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing  
19 as Section 217 of the Official ReCompilation of the  
20 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, the city  
21 governing body of the City of Midfield in Jefferson County may  
22 levy, in addition to any other tax, an ad valorem tax in the  
23 amount of 14 mills on each dollar of taxable property in the  
24 city. The revenue from the additional tax shall be paid to the  
25 city general fund to be used for general municipal purposes.

26 Section 2. The increase in the rate of the tax as  
27 provided by this act is subject to the approval of a majority

1 of the qualified electors of the city who vote on the proposed  
2 increase at the next general, primary, constitutional, or  
3 special election held for that purpose.

4 Section 3. This act shall become effective  
5 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
6 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
